Preface: "Lists of all men between the ages of eighteen and forty-five residing in each town or ward, prepared by sheriffs of each county in response to Wisconsin General Order No. 99 (August 9, 1862), showing name, age and occupation. Where a listed person was already in military service, his military unit is shown. Occasional remarks indicate medical or legal reasons for possible exemption of an individual from military duty. A line was drawn through the name of each person so exempted. Record covers Adams, Ashland, Brown, Buffalo, Brunett, Columbia, Eau Claire, Fond du Lac, Lafayette, Manitowoc, Marathon, Marquette, Monroe, Oconto, Outagamie, Ozaukee, Pierce, Polk, Portage, Racine, Richland, Rock, St. Croix, Sauk, Shawano, Sheboygan and Trempealelau counties."

The following are the names, as written in the document, of immigrants from the Kaszuby region who were residents of Portage County, WI, in August of 1862. The lists were compiled under the direction of Deputy Sheriff James E. LzIte (?) and Deputy Sheriff H. Jack. The information in parenthesis is this writer's interpretation of the individual's name, parish (Polish and German name), and immigration year based on extensive research of the early immigrants from the Kaszuby region to Portage County.
